Dear Parents, Carers and the Lemington community,

It's been a great first couple of weeks back here at school – the children look incredibly smart in their new uniforms and the atmosphere around the building has been great.

SLIGHT CHANGE TO MORNING ENTRANCES:

To ease congestion at the main entrance in the morning there will be some slight changes to entrances from tomorrow (Tuesday 28th September):

- ✓ Children in Years 1, 2 and 3 should continue to use the Main Entrance on Sugley Street between 8:45 and 9am.
- ✓ Children in Years 4, 5 and 6 should now enter through the double doors on the Rokeby Street side of the main building 8:45am and 9am.

There will continue to be at least one member of staff at each entrance welcoming the children into school. There is no change to our Nursery/Reception arrangements.
