COVID-19 UPDATE:



It has been a challenging start to 2021 with remote learning in place for the majority of our children since the start of term. The Prime Minister has indicated pupils **may** begin to return to school from Monday 8th March dependent on a number of factors – we will be monitoring developments closely and will inform you through our website and social media channels of any updates as and when we receive them.

I would like to place on record my thanks to the parents and carers who are working so hard at home to support their children with remote learning, often whilst trying to balance this with working from home. You are doing a fantastic job in very trying circumstances!

I am sure that you will all agree that the teachers and teaching assistants should also be commended for their amazing effort in pulling together online learning at such short notice. They are working tirelessly every day to provide good quality lessons for your children via Seesaw and Tapestry, whilst at the same time giving live feedback and challenges to keep your child learning from home.

Our pastoral staff have also been in regular contact with many of you throughout lockdown and I know how valuable many of our children have found this.

We have loaned over 50 laptops and wireless routers to families in our school during the current lockdown to enable children to access home learning. Following my appearance on ITV Tyne Tees News in early January, where I talked about the lack of technology support we had received from the Government, we received two very generous, anonymous financial donations to the school that have enabled us to purchase laptops and routers to support our families. We are so grateful for these kind donations.







FREE SCHOOL MEALS:

We know that many of our personal circumstances have changed in the past year. We would encourage you, if your circumstances have changed, to consider applying for free school meals if you are not already entitled to them. The form is quick and easy to complete and can be found at this link:
