Dear parents, carers and the Lemington community,

IMPORTANT: End of day time changes for Nursery & Reception:

We are pleased to confirm that from the start of this term, the Nursery and Reception class days will be extended. This means that **Nursery class will finish at 3:00pm** Monday – Thursday (2:00pm Friday) and **Reception class will finish at 3:15pm** Monday – Thursday (2:15pm Friday). All other classes will continue to finish at 3:15pm Monday-Thursday and 2:15pm on Friday. Please note, the staggered start dates for Early Years children still apply this week.

Homework Club

Our free homework club will continue to operate every Friday until 3:15pm for all children who wish to attend – please ensure you have filled in the form attached to this letter if you wish your child to attend homework club & return to school ASAP.

Uniform:

Thank you for all of the lovely feedback re. our free uniform bundles this summer. We will continue to work hard to come up with innovative solutions to help everybody as the cost of living continues to pose so many challenges for us all. Due to a slight delay from our suppliers, some of the bundles were delayed, but everything has arrived now and should be with you this week if you didn't receive it before we broke

School uniform is a blue jumper/cardigan or hoodie, white polo shirt or button-up shirt/blouse, school trousers or skirt, school shoes or dark, plain trainers.
