Dear Parents, Carers and the community of Lemington,

First of all, thank you for making me feel so welcome over the past week or so – it's been great to meet you all.

PARENT/CARER SURVEY ACTIONS:

Thank you to everybody who took the time to fill out our parent/carer survey. It's been really useful to find out your opinions of the school, what we do well and where we could improve. Well done to Mya's mum from Y4/5 who won the $\pounds 10$ voucher for `Coffee on the Corner'!

I am working hard at putting together an action plan for the school to help us to continue to move forward; all of your ideas will all feed into that action plan.

There have been some immediate changes that I have made based on your feedback:

- Many of you asked if we could have a **Sports Day** I can confirm that we will have a Sports Day in Summer 2019. We will confirm the exact arrangements for this closer to the time.
- Some of you asked for more advanced notice of events that are taking place in school. I have updated the calendar on our website and our Facebook, Twitter and Instagram pages are now up and running. On our calendar, you will find all of the school holiday dates up to Summer 2020.
- From Monday 21st January, all of our classrooms will open from
 8:45am from Nursery up to Year 6 (previously Nursery/Reception opened at 9am). This means that you now have a 15 minute window to get your child into school in time for the register at 9am.
- Many of you said that you would like us to do more work around antibullying. I can confirm that we will be joined on 25th and 26th March by a national anti-bullying ambassador, Ann Foxley-Johnson. Ann will work

with our children to create a LRPS Anti-Bullying Team. Ann will also be holding a parent/carer/grandparent workshop on the morning of **Tuesday 26th March at 9am** where she will explore how you can help keep your child safe outside of school and in the online world - it would be great to see as many people there as possible (there will be free tea/coffee and cakes too!). Ann will also run training for our staff and Governors.

In the coming weeks we will be sending out some updates on our reward systems for excellent attendance and the processes we may work through if your child's attendance is causing us concern.


