As we approach the end of the term, the children are getting very excited to share with you their end of term performances next week! Firstly, a reminder of all of the Christmas events taking place between now and the end of term:

## **Thursday 15th December:**

- Christmas dinner day. Children are welcome to wear Christmas jumpers and accessories if they wish.
- We are being visited by some **very special** visitors from the North Pole!

## Friday 16th December:

- The children will be visiting **Sugley Church** in Lemington for a special Christmas service. This visit is classed as a local visit, so parents/carers do not need to sign a consent form. **If** you have any questions or would <u>not</u> like your child to attend, please inform the school office no later than Thursday 15th December.

# **Monday 19th December:**

# **Wednesday 21st December:**

- 9:30am and 1:30pm: Upper Years (Years 4/5/6) Christmas performances in the Main Hall. You can arrive up to 15 minutes before the performance begins. **Each performance is strictly ticket only.** There will be a 50/50 cash prize draw at each performance, with tickets priced at £1 each.
