Dear Parents and Carers,

ATTENDANCE:

As before lockdown, the Department for Education now states that school attendance is **a legal requirement for all children**. Please ensure that your child is in school, on time by 9, every morning.

If your child or anybody in your household bubble develops symptoms of Covid-19 (new persistent cough, high temperature, loss/change of taste/smell) you must self-isolate, seek a test for the person with symptoms and inform us at your earliest convenience on **0191 267 4315** or by emailing admin@lemingtonriverside.newcastle.sch.uk.

If your child is absent for any other reason, please inform the office on 0191 267 4315.

We must remind you that if your child's attendance is a cause for concern, we will offer you a virtual meeting to discuss the reasons for this and if, following this meeting, there is still no improvement it may be necessary for us to refer your child's attendance to the Local Authority for legal monitoring.

TERM TIME HOLIDAYS:

Term-time holidays cannot be authorised by the Head Teacher (this is another directive from the Department for Education). If your child does need to be absent during term-time, you must inform us by completing a term-time absence notification form. Copies of this can be requested from the school office or can be completed on our website by clicking on *Parents > Term-Time Holidays*.







SCHOOL MEALS:

If you pay for school meals you can now do this through the **ParentPay** app. We encourage all parents to begin using ParentPay now as from September 2021 we will no longer accept cash payments for school dinners in school.

Please note, you must give us at least one weeks' notice if your child wishes to change from packed lunches to school meals or vice versa. A number of children continue to switch between packed lunches and school meals without notifying Mrs. Casey and this is causing a knock-on effect in the school kitchen.
