A Year One Reader	
Word Reading	Comprehension
 I can match all 40+ graphemes to their phonemes. 	\checkmark I can say what I like and do not like about a text.
 I can blend sounds in unfamiliar words. 	\checkmark I can link what I have heard or read to my own experiences.
✓ I can divide words into syllables.	\checkmark I can retell key stories orally using narrative language.
✓ I can read compound words.	\checkmark I can talk about the main characters within a well known story.
 I can read words with contractions and understand that the apostrophe represents the missing letters. 	\checkmark I can learn some poems and rhymes by heart.
\checkmark I can read words that end with 's, -ing, -ed, -est.	 I can check that my reading makes good sense and go back to correct when it doesn't.
\checkmark I can read words which start with un	\checkmark I can draw inferences from the text and / or the illustrations.
 ✓ I can add –ing, -ed, and –er to verbs. (where no change is needed to the root word). 	\checkmark I can make predictions about the events in the text.
 I can read words of more than one syllable that contain taught GPCs. 	\checkmark I can explain what I think a text is about.
