

What to do if.....	Action Needed	Return to school when.....
<p>My child has Covid-19 symptoms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> HIGH TEMPERATURE- this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back. A NEW CONTINUOUS COUGH – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours. A LOSS OR CHANGE TO YOUR SENSE OF SMELL OR TASTE - this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything. 	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL Contact school to inform us. Self-isolate the child for 10 days. Self-isolate the other members of the household for 14 days. Get a test for the child. SEND YOUR TEST RESULTS IMMEDIATELY TO SCHOOL.</p>	<p>The test comes back negative.</p>
<p>My child tests positive for Covid 19.</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL Contact school to inform us. Agree an earliest date for return – minimum of 10 days from positive test result Self-isolate your child for 10 days / whole household for 14 days. Bubble isolates/remote learning provided</p>	<p>They feel better. They can return after 10 days even if they have a cough or loss of taste/smell. These symptoms can last for several weeks.</p>
<p>My child tests negative.</p>	<p>CONTACT THE SCHOOL Send school your test results Discuss when your child can come back to school (same or next day)</p>	<p>The test comes back negative and you have provided school a copy of your results.</p>
<p>My child is ill with symptoms not linked to Covid 19.</p>	<p>FOLLOW USUAL SCHOOL ABSENCE POLICY PROCEDURE.</p>	<p>Symptoms have gone away.</p>
<p>Someone in my household has Covid 19 symptoms.</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL Arrange a test for the affected household member only. Other household members should only get a test if they begin to show symptoms. Contact school. Self- isolate your child for 10 days / whole household for 14 days. INFORM SCHOOL IMMEDIATELY ABOUT TEST RESULTS (COPY REQUIRED)</p>	<p>The test comes back negative.</p>
<p>Someone in my household tests positive for Covid 19.</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL Contact school Self-isolate the person with the positive test for 10 days / household for 14 days. Other household members should only get a test if they begin to show symptoms. Agree an earliest possible return date. Minimum of 14 days</p>	<p>The child has completed 14 days of isolation.</p>
<p>NHS Test and Trace has identified my child has been in close contact of someone with symptoms of confirmed Covid-19.</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL CONTACT SCHOOL Agree an earliest possible return date. Minimum of 14 days</p>	<p>The child has completed 14 days of isolation.</p>
<p>We/my child has travelled and has to self-isolate as a period of quarantine.</p>	<p>Do not take unauthorised leave in term time. Consider quarantine requirements and FCO advice when booking travel. Inform school of your destination of travel. Agree an earliest date for possible return. Minimum of 14 days from return date. Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days.</p>	<p>The quarantine period of 14 days has been completed</p>
<p>We have received medical advice that my child must resume shielding</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL CONTACT SCHOOL Shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused again.</p>	<p>School informs you that restrictions have been lifted and your child can return to school.</p>
<p>My child's bubble is closed due to a Covid 19 outbreak in school.</p>	<p>DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL At home support for your child with remote education provided by the school Your child will need to isolate for 14 days.</p>	<p>School will inform you when the bubble will be reopened.</p>
