2. Issue caused by Covid & strategy identified			
<p>a) <b>Issue identified/intent:</b> Children in the Early Years Foundation Stage have missed key socialisation opportunities, we need to give all children in Reception the opportunity to catch up on missed opportunities from their time in Nursery/pre-School. <b>Implementation:</b> Additional tutoring to be offered by EYFS team x 1 hour per week for the Autumn, Spring and Summer terms focusing on speaking &amp; listening and social skills. We will encourage high levels of engagement from families by offering an incentive for all children to attend (visit to Waterstones each term where the children can choose a book each to the value of £10). <b>Impact:</b> The % of Reception children reaching a GLD will be in line with the pre-Covid national average. <b>Budgeted cost:</b> Additional tutoring costs for staff (1 x teacher and 1 x unqualified teacher for three terms, £1,375). Incentives for each child to attend x 5 half terms, £1,150). Light evening snack at each session @ £1 per child x 25 hourly sessions = £575). <b>TOTAL: £3,100</b></p>			
<p>b) <b>Issue identified/intent:</b> Children in the Years 1-6 have missed significant key learning in English (including Early Reading and Phonics) and mathematics. The intention is to provide high-quality after-school tutoring for all children. <b>Implementation:</b> Additional tutoring to be offered by Qualified Teachers employed at Lemington Riverside x 1 hour per week for the Autumn, Spring and Summer terms focusing on reading and mathematical skills. We will encourage high levels of engagement from families by offering an incentive for all children to attend (£10 Amazon voucher per child, per half term, for full attendance). <b>Impact:</b> The % of children reaching ARE at the end of Years 1-6 will be in line with the pre-Covid national average, based on previous assessment data and Fischer Family Trust (FFT) data. <b>Budgeted cost:</b> Additional tutoring costs for staff (6 x teachers for three terms (25 hours of Tuition), £3,750). Incentives for each child to attend x 5 half terms, £6,000). Light evening snack at each session @ £1 per child x 25 hourly sessions = £3000). <b>TOTAL: £12,750</b></p>
