You must select items from our homework menu to complete. Each quality piece of homework is worth 5 house points, so please feel free to complete as many as you like!


Present it - How has crime and punishment changed in this country over the years? Can you create a fact file containing all of the gruesome methods in which criminals were punished with and compare them with today's methods?
