<u>Item discussed</u>	<u>Action to be taken and by whom</u>
What will we do with the Easter Fair money to improve playtimes? Decided that we need a questionnaire to ask 2 questions- What would make the playground better? What would make playtimes better?	

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Should we do one questionnaire per class or year group, or one per child? OT suggested one per child as shy children might miss out. CA suggested one per class to save time. We voted and decided on one per child for fairness.	Questionnaires will be printed today and members will collect them for their class. Members will let everyone know in assembly and questionnaires should be returned in the box outside of the office by Weds 4 th May.

<u>Item discussed</u>	<u>Action to be taken and by whom</u>
We shared some of our own ideas- Gates to separate the yards and make them safer. Pathways painted on the yards and games e.g. more hopscotch etc, to make more challenging. Can they chalk if not painted on? A weekly obstacle course set up by playground buddies with challenges for different classes. More buddies to set up games- have a buddy box of toys etc. that they set up in yard. Learn playtime games. Racing tracks and starting flags. New basketball hoop KS1 Stopwatches and timers available so they can do team games and challenges. Separate zones in the playground- e.g. quiet zone, football zone, games zone. We need to discuss how they could be separated. More mixed playtimes with the whole school.	All of these ideas will be discussed further after the questionnaires are collected, as well as all of the responses from those before we discuss our findings and follow up with Mrs Hall and Mrs Hinshaw.
