Dear Parents, Carers and the community of Lemington,

Thank you for all of your support and positivity during our first half term together, it was a really successful few weeks. There is a lot more to come this half term!

HOUSE POINTS:

We continue to use house points in school to reward great work and positive behaviours. Congratulations to children in Tyne Bridge House who were our house point champions last half term. Their reward is a non-uniform day this Friday $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ March.

ATTENDANCE:

The attendance of our children is low compared to other local schools and schools nationally. If your child's attendance dips below 95% we will send you a parent contract offer – this is the opportunity for you to discuss reasons your child's attendance is below 95% and for us to offer any support we can. If, after this contract offer, your child's attendance continues to remain a concern we will refer to the local authority who will legally monitor. Failure of the legal monitoring process can result in fines and even prosecution. Please have a look at our 'Attendance' section on the website where there is a lot of guidance on when you should and should not keep your child off school.

All children with attendance above the national average (97%) for the full term (January – Easter Holidays) will be given a special reward at the end of this half term!

WORLD BOOK DAY 2019:

World Book Day takes place on Thursday 7th March. Children are welcome (but do not have to) come to school dressed as their favourite book character – no donation is required. We would also encourage children to bring in their favourite book to share with their class mates. All children will receive a book voucher on the day that can be spent in a number of local book shops and supermarkets.

SPORT UPDATE:

- on Thursday 14th February a selection of Y5/6 boys represented our school in the Duffy League (West Newcastle League) at Walbottle Campus in three league games. It was a fantastic evening of football with LRPS gaining 2 wins and narrowly losing 1 game. We beat Throckley 2-1 and Farne 3-0, losing 1-2 to a strong Knop Law side. Goals on the evening were scored by Kai Thirtle (2), Lewis Shaw, Jack Carter, Neirin Driver and Liam Carver. As one of the smallest schools in the league, it is a great achievement to pick up such positive results. Our next league fixtures will take place on **Thursday 14th March** Duffy League (West Newcastle League) (4-5:30pm at Walbottle Campus).
- We will be running trials in school for the Newcastle School's Cross Country Championships that we will be entering for the first time this year. The competition is open to children in Years 3-4 and Years 5-6. There will be four separate races (3-4 girls/3-4 boys/5-6 girls, 5-6 boys). The top 4 children from each trial race in school will qualify for the finals that take place at Blakelaw Park on the afternoon of Tuesday 2nd April.

NEW BEHAVIOUR POLICY:

Thank you for all of the positive feedback on our new 'Positive Behaviour and Assertive Discipline' policy. The policy is now 'live' and has been explained in detail to all of our children. All of our staff are now fully trained in our approach to behaviour management. The policy is available for you to read on our website in the 'Parent and Carer Info' section – I would advise that all parents have a skim over this so that you are clear on how we will reward children who always behave well and also how we will deal with any poor behaviour.
